Sealed bids for **WINTHROP & SOUTH STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS** will be received at the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer at City Hall, 85 George P. Hassett Drive, Room 105, Medford, MA 02155 **until 2:00 pm on Thursday, March 23, 2017**, immediately after which the bids will be opened and read publicly. The estimated value of the Contract is \$192,000. The Contract shall commence immediately upon signature of the Contract and will end on or about August 31, 2017.

Contractors must be pre-qualified with the Massachusetts Department of Transportation at the time of submitting their bid to the City.

Bid documents will be available, free of charge, on or after **March 2, 2017** from the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer or by emailing Thupten Chukhatsang at tlama@medford-ma.gov.

There will be a pre-bid conference at **11:00 am on Wednesday, March 15, 2017, at Room 207, Medford City Hall.**

Bid Deposit: Bid bond, cash, or certified or Treasurer's check in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the value of the proposed work

Surety Bonds: Labor & Materials Payment Bond – fifty percent (50%) of Contract price

Insurance Coverage is required at the time of award.

This Bid is subject to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30 §39M, as amended to date.

This project is funded in whole or in part with Federal monies and required provisions for federally assisted construction contracts apply. The City of Medford is an Equal Opportunity Employer and contractors must comply with the MBE/WBE/DBE participation requirements in response to the bid process. Both the Massachusetts Minimum Wage Rates and the Davis Bacon Wage Rates will be incorporated into the bid documents and the best and highest wage rate will prevail.

The City of Medford reserves the right to accept any bid, in whole or in part, to reject any/or all bids and to waive minor irregularities and/or informalities as it deems to be in the best interest of the City.
