Sealed bids for **2017 ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION & REPAVING** will be received at the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer at City Hall, 85 George P. Hassett Drive, Room 105, Medford, MA 02155 **until 2:00 pm on Monday April 24, 2017**, immediately after which the bids will be opened and read publicly. The estimated value of the Contract is \$850,000. This Contract will commence on or about May 22, 2017 and should end no later than June 30, 2018. The project consists of cold plane/milling of approximately 24,700 square yards of asphalt on 5 different roadway sections, pulverizing 9000 square yards on 2 different roadways, necessary repairs to the roadway base or binder, adjustment or replacement of utility castings, rebuilding of damaged sections of manholes or catch basins, placing 2 ½" binder course, resurfacing with 1 ½" to 2" of asphalt top course, replacing traffic detection loops; and painting of traffic lines, symbols, lettering, and crosswalks.

Bid documents will be available, free of charge, on or after **April 7, 2017**, from the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer or electronically by emailing a request for the documents to Erin Carson at [ecarson@medford-ma.gov](mailto:ecarson@medford-ma.gov).

**Bid Deposit:** Bid bond, cash, or certified or Treasurer's check in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the value of the proposed work

**Surety Bonds:** Labor & Materials Payment Bond – fifty percent (50%) of Contract price

**Contractors must be pre-qualified with the Massachusetts Department of Transportation at the time of submitting their bid to the City.**

This Bid is subject to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30(39M), as amended to date. Insurance Coverage is required at the time of award.

The City of Medford is an Equal Opportunity Employer, and encourages MBE/WBE/DBE participation in response to the bid process. **Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates apply to this Contract.**

The City of Medford reserves the right to accept any bid, in whole or in part, to reject any/or all bids and to waive minor irregularities and/or informalities as it deems to be in the best interest of the City.
