RIVERBEND PARK OFF-LEASH RECREATION AREA (OLRA)**

Sealed Bids for **Riverbend Park Off-leash Recreation Area (OLRA)** will be received at the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer, City Hall, Room 105, Medford, MA **until 2:00 pm, Tuesday April 4, 2017**, immediately after which the bids will be opened and read publicly.

The work consists of: site preparation, stripping of topsoil, rough grading; 14' metal gazebo shelter on a concrete slab, creation of two OLRA areas, one of 12,000 s.f. and one of 4,000 s.f., both with a 4" rice stone play surface, set on a drain gravel base, 5' black vinyl coated chain link fence, bit. conc. paths, benches, water spigots and other site improvements; irrigation systems for both OLRA areas; an ADA compliant bituminous concrete path system connecting all proposed element; drainage, water supply from the community garden for the irrigation system and spigots; new electric power system from the existing line at the parking area for lighting and irrigation control; light fixtures and signage.

The estimated value of the Contract is \$250,000,00.

**Bid Deposit:** Bid bond, cash, or certified or Treasurer's check in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the value of the proposed work.

**Labor & Materials Payment Bond:** 50% of the value of the proposed work.

**Performance Bond:** None

Insurance Coverage is required at time of award.

This Contract is in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M.
