The City of Medford is seeking proposals from qualified Contractors to provide Environmental Services. The firm must be licensed and lawfully engaged in providing such services in the State of Massachusetts. The Contract shall commence immediately upon signature of the Contract and will end on or about March 31, 2019.

Proposers are asked to submit one original and four (4) copies of each proposal in a sealed envelope clearly marked "**RFP 17-0087 – Comprehensive Remedial Action – Former 448 High Street Site**". Proposals received after the time and date indicated will not be considered.

This RFP is subject to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30B, as amended to date.

This project is funded in whole or in part with Federal monies and required provisions for federally assisted construction contracts apply. The City of Medford is an Equal Opportunity Employer and contractors must comply with the MBE/WBE/DBE participation requirements in response to the bid process. Both the Massachusetts Minimum Wage Rates and the Davis Bacon Wage Rates will be incorporated into the bid documents and the best and highest wage rate will prevail.
