Dear Mr. President and Members of the Medford City Council:

In accordance with the provisions of G.L. c. 44 § 53A, I respectfully request and recommend that your Honorable Body approve the acceptance of an unconditional gift to the City of Medford from Hallmark Health Corporation of 170 Governors Avenue, Medford, MA 02155 in the amount of \$4,500.

It is intended that this gift will be used to support a program called "*Produce in a SNAP for Seniors*" which provides subsidized farm shares to residents over 60 years of age living in Medford. It will provide them better access to the freshest locally grown produce thanks to a collaboration with four local organizations: the Medford Farmers Market, the Board of Health/ Mass in Motion, the Medford Housing Authority and New Entry Sustainable Farming Project.
