City of Medford Outdoor Heater Safety Rules and Guidelines

Location

- Heaters <u>cannot</u> be placed under any tents or coverings.
 - Heaters must be placed <u>at least</u> 10 feet away from any tents.
- Heaters must be <u>at least</u> 5 feet away from exits and any combustibles.

Storage

- Heaters and tanks <u>cannot</u> be stored inside a building, they must be stored outside and in an approved spot by Fire Prevention.
- Before heaters and tanks are stored at the end of the day, there must be at least a 45-minute cool-down period allowed.
- When not in use, tanks **must be** disconnected and locked away.

Operation

- Ensure that there is no obstruction to the air ventilation.
- Ensure that all connections are tight and there are no leaks.
- All debris must be clear where heaters are being operated.
- Heaters must be used according to the manufacturer's instructions. Any heaters borrowed from the City will be accompanied by an instruction manual.
