

Mystic to Woburn Line Project
Construction Update for Medford, MA
Increased Traffic in Your Area

Dear Neighbor,

Eversource construction crews have been working in your neighborhood for several months as part of the Mystic to Woburn Line Project. Currently, construction activity is continuing on South Street. This work is part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to you, our customer. As we perform this necessary work, we are continuing to follow the Covid-19 health guidance issued by federal, state, and regulatory officials.

We're Always Working to Serve You Better

In the coming weeks, crews will be working to install a new underground transmission line that will connect our Woburn Substation on Pond Street in Woburn with our Mystic Substation off Alford Street in Everett. The line will extend approximately 8 miles between the two substations and will pass through Woburn, Winchester, Medford, Somerville, Boston (Charlestown), and Everett. As aforementioned, this work is part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to you, our customer.

What You Can Expect

First, we want you to know that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property. Eversource is working with local officials to ensure traffic is managed in a manner that maintains safe working conditions and minimizes impacts to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Please note that Eversource and local officials may make in-field alterations as necessary.

For the next several weeks, crews will continue excavating trench and installing pipe to contain the new transmission cable on South Street in Medford. To make room for this challenging work, South Street will remain closed to non-local traffic, Monday through Friday from 7 am – 4 pm and traffic detours will be in place near your home. Traffic from South Street will continue to be redirected to Manning Street, Walnut Street, Emerson Street, and other side streets in the vicinity of South Street.
